Dear Joe,

This document is to address the criteria needed to accumulate points for the LEED certification program and how Cool Metal Roofing, your ULTRA-Cool products, can meet the criteria.

The four levels of certification for LEED are as follows:

- Certified Level – 26-32 points
- Silver Level – 33-38 points
- Gold Level – 39-51 points
- Platinum Level – 52+ points
- Total possible points – 69 points

The Whole Building Approach encourages and guides a collaborative, integrated design and construction process. From the point achievement capabilities of Cool Metal Roofing, you will see how Cool Metal impacts the point achievement in a major way.

Metal's contribution to meeting these LEED point levels is as follows:

- Heat Island Effect, roof – 1 point
- Recycled Content – 2 points
- Recyclability of substrate – 6 points
- Energy Optimization – Up to 10 points
- Impervious Nature/rainwater – 5 points
